This event is conducted at the Chowchilla Police Department, 122 Trinity Avenue, across from the Chowchilla Post Office from 9-10AM for seniors and persons with disabilities, and 10AM-12:00NN for the general community.

Dogs can receive Parvo/ Distemper, Rabies and Worming shots. Cats can receive FVRCD, Rabies and Worming shots.

ALL CATS MUST BE BROUGHT IN CARRIERS.

Pet microchipping will be available for \$22.50.

New and renewal pet licenses will also be processed on-site during the Pet Vaccine Clinic.

Donations of much needed dog and cat food for the Chowchilla Animal Shelter can be dropped off at the clinic.

City hires Fire Battalion Chief

Lifelong Chowchilla resident, Fred Gaumnitz, was hired by the City of Chowchilla as the new Fire Battalion Chief, the first in the history of the City's Fire Department.



Fred has been a volunteer member of the Fire Department for more than 12 years. During his tenure he has served as a firefighter, Captain, Training Captain, and prior to his appointment as Fire Battalion Chief, he served as the volunteer Assistant Fire Chief.

As Fire Battalion Chief Fred will manage all fire operations personnel in mitigating emergency incidents including fire suppression, emergency medical services, hazardous materials services, and technical rescue services.

He will be very involved with the implementation of fire prevention and public education programs in addition to training of City staff and volunteer firefighters.

Fred's responsibility also include technical and administrative duties and will be providing citywide emergency management oversight.

The Battalion Chief position was made possible by the new Public Safety Sales Tax passed by voters in November 2018.

Chowchilla Fairgrounds hosts ACTRA Pro Team Ropers

The Chowchilla Fairgrounds has again been selected to host the American Cowboy Team Roping Association (ACTRA) California Chapter Roping Finals. This year the event will be Thursday through Sunday, September 19-22. This is a FREE viewing event and is a very important qualifier leading to the Nor-Cal National Finals Qualifier at the end of September.

About 2,000 roping teams along with their family and friends are expected to participate in this year's event in Chowchilla, meaning nearly 6,000 people are expected to visit our city during this important 4-day event.

Daily roping activities will be held in the two covered fairgrounds arenas and feature roping events designed for professional team ropers as well as families and individuals who pursue the sport as a hobby. The California Chapter Roping Finals is the largest roping event in the state with total cash awards to competitors exceeding \$300,000.
