



Low Income Household Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) & Low Income Household Water Assistance Program (LIHWAP)

WHAT IS LIHEAP?

The Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) is a federally funded program that offers a variety of home energy assistance for those in need. LIHEAP helps individuals and families meet their energy needs through utility bill assistance and energy efficiency upgrades.

Your household may be eligible to receive a one-time credit on your PG&E bill. You must be income eligible, meet the LIHEAP Priority Plan criteria and have not applied during the current year to receive the credit. This program is not for emergency assistance and will take between 30-90 days for the credit to be applied to your PG&E Bill.

WHAT IS LIHWAP?

LIHWAP is a federally funded program that offers low-income households a one-time payment to help pay outstanding bills for residential water or wastewater costs. In the wake of the COVID-19 pandemic, the federal government awarded California funding to help households struggling to afford the costs of water, and many Californians in need may qualify.

HOW DO I APPLY?

1. Return completed and signed Application Packet
2. Provide COPY of the APPLICANT'S Social Security card
3. Provide ALL proof of total household income for the previous six weeks of the date of submission. For Example: COPIES of check stubs, award letters for SSI/SSP/SSA, unemployment check stubs, general relief letters, child support, pensions letters for the current year, and Verification of Benefits for the month of application for all household members receiving TANF, General Aid, Cal-Fresh or Medical.
4. Provide a photocopy of a COMPLETE PG&E bill, all pages front and back, AND the last propane delivery tag if you have propane.
5. Provide a photocopy of a COMPLETE Water bill, all pages front and back.
6. Applicants must provide their own photocopies.



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
