Madera County, CA: Madera County is partnering with the incorporated communities of Chowchilla and Madera to update their 2018 Local Hazard Mitigation Plan (LHMP). Floods, drought, wildfires, and severe weather are just a few of the hazards of concern to Madera County. While natural hazards such as these cannot be prevented, an LHMP forms the foundation for a community's long-term strategy to reduce disaster losses by breaking the repeated cycle of disaster damage and reconstruction. Communities with a FEMA-approved LHMP are eligible to apply for both pre- and post-disaster mitigation grant funding.

You are invited. We encourage the public and all interested stakeholders to attend and participate in our upcoming project kickoff meetings. An initial Public Meeting will explain the LHMP development process, the benefits of hazard mitigation planning, and how you can be involved.
