
### Come out and enjoy your Chowchilla Fair

### Well failure delays start of summer watering schedule

The recent mechanical pump failure of a major water producing well for Chowchilla water customers has delayed the start for the summer outside irrigation schedule. The City enacted STAGE III of the City's Water Conservation Plan. Until the well is repaired and able to provide full capacity water distribution, OUTSIDE IRRIGATION WILL REMAIN AT THE ONE-DAY A WEEK OUTSIDE WATERING SCHEDULE.

Everyone is asked to help maintain the needed water pressure for indoor household use by not irrigating lawns and outdoor landscapes on any day other than the SATURDAY ONLY schedule for EVEN number addresses, and the SUNDAY ONLY schedule for ODD number addresses. Outdoor landscape watering is prohibited every day from 10AM to 7PM.

City officials sincerely apologize for the inconvenience the pump failure has caused and appreciate everyone's understanding as they work to make the emergency repairs.

Bilingual staff are needed. People fluent in Spanish or Punjabi will be given preference in hiring.


